Transitional Sampler: What to expect in Secondary School	9	<p>This course will support learners in developing skills needed for a successful transition to Secondary School. Students will continue to hone their organizational skills, study skills, technology skills and media literacy skills and will also preview key themes and concepts in the areas of Literacy and Numeracy – all of which will better prepare them for their first year at Secondary School.</p> <p>Dates: July 4 – 14 Times: 8:15am – 12:45pm</p>

Course	Grade	Description
Sustainable Vegetable Production	9 – 12	<p>Students will be taught about food production through practical, hands-on experiences. Students will learn skills in land preparation, planning, weed control, pest management, fertilizing, pruning, harvesting, marketing and sales and culinary opportunities. Students will work alongside community partners who are specialists in the various commodities grown. Students will take food home on harvest days and be encouraged to prepare and eat the food grown with their families.</p> <p>Location: Sardis Secondary Farm (7175 Richardson Avenue)</p> <p>Dates: Tuesdays and Thursdays, July 4 – August 24</p> <p>Students must attend 8 out of 16 possible dates. Students must also spend time at home preparing food (or do additional days on-site).</p> <p>*All students must be in attendance Tuesday, July 4th for the Program Orientation and BBQ.</p> <p>Time: 8:00am – 2:00pm</p> <p>*Bussing will NOT be provided.</p>
